



COCKROACHES – TREATMENT PREPARATION

What should I do around my home to help prepare for cockroach treatment?

Your home/unit is going to be treated for cockroaches. In order to allow for successful treatment and to maximize on the treatment taking place it is imperative that the following steps be taken to prepare your home/unit.

- Be sure you and your pets are prepared to vacate the property for three to four hours after treatment to allow sufficient time for treatment and subsequent ventilation.
- Remove all items including food and dishware from kitchen cupboards and also from underneath kitchen sink and also contents from cupboards in washrooms.
- Remove all items from bedroom and hallway closets.
- Move large objects such as wall units, couches and other furniture items away from baseboards as a residual spray treatment will be applied to the baseboards.
- After three to four hours has passed you and your pets can return and put your personal belongings back in cupboards.
- Do not wash or mop baseboard areas for three weeks following treatment. Sweeping will not affect treatment.
